



Online Auctions Benefit the SAG Foundation

The Screen Actors Guild Awards® recently completed its Holiday Auction, the first of three online auctions to benefit the Screen Actors Guild Foundation. A bevy of items were up for bid between Dec. 5 and Dec. 15, 2013, including autographed memorabilia, unique gifts such as a Scarlett Johansson outgoing voicemail recording; tickets to Broadway's "After Midnight" with a backstage meet-and-greet with Dule Hill; and a VIP package to attend the SAG Awards® ceremony and gala on Saturday, January 18, 2014. SAG Awards® VIP package included: two coach tickets on United Airlines, a three-night stay at the Montage Beverly Hills, and a SAG Awards® backstage tour on rehearsal day.

Next up, the Bleacher Seat Auction, slated for Jan. 2, will accept bids for over 100 seats in the bleachers, from which fans can cheer the 20th Annual SAG Awards® nominees and presenters as they make their way down the red carpet. Finally, the Ceremony Auction, slated for Jan. 16, will revolve around the nominated actors, ensembles, presenters, sponsors and credentialed media. In previous years, the last auction has included autographed scripts and posters, wardrobe, props as well as set visits to studios.
