I've sent out my preemptive thanks to everyone involved in this, especially Marney.

But mostly, given the subject matter, this is for my nephew Michael and my sister Pam.

I lost Michael -- I lost my nephew Michael to drugs, and it hurts. This is for my sister Pam.
